



STOP THE PYLONS!

180km of 164ft (50m) high pylons are proposed in East Anglia, the route cuts right across LANGHAM, BOXTED, GREAT HORKESELY, WEST BERGHOLT.

They have 2 options,

- 1) Monster pylon blots on our landscape or**
- 2) Run cables under the sea around the coast.**

We MUST push for the 2nd under sea route.

SAY NO to the 50m high scar across our landscape.

What does this mean for Boxted and surrounding areas?

- 180km of 400kV overhead cables (the highest voltage) cutting through countryside, past villages, schools and near historic buildings through Essex, Suffolk and Norfolk
- 50-metre high pylons (except in the Dedham AONB, where they will be buried.....**WE are outside the AONB pylon area, so we will get pylons**)
- Approximately 1300 pylons in total... **Remember a 50m pylon is over 8 times the height of a 2 storey house**, thats **11 busses** on top of each other high.
